Storms

The Philippines is the most storm-exposed country in the world, experiencing an average of 18-19 tropical storms a year. 2013's catastrophic Typhoon Haiyan, Philippine name Yolanda, is the most powerful tropical storm on record.



Earthquakes

The Philippine islands are located on the Pacific Ring of Fire, which means the country experiences frequent seismic and volcanic activity. The country experiences an average of 887 earthquakes every year.

Power outages

The Philippines has approximately 30 million more people than Thailand, but produces only half the electricity. The Philippines has been grappling with chronic power shortages for years.

From 2000-2012, the Philippines experienced 72 flooding events, including the 2012 Manila habagat with damages assessed at Php 604.63 million, and the January 2014 Mindanao floods which affected over 900.000 people.


