

Circular on Administrative Fines

Total imposable fine shall not exceed Five Million Pesos (Php 5,000,000.00)

- Online Public Consultation attended by more than 160 stakeholders from various sectors – 22 March 2022
- Extension of Submission of Comments on the Draft Guidelines on Administrative Fines – until 21 April 2022
- Currently undergoing the Regulatory Impact Assessment (RIA) by the Legal Division of the NPC





Circular on Administrative Fines

Admin Fine: 0.5 % to 3 % of the annual gross income of the immediately preceding year of the violation

Grave Violations (where the total number of affected data subject exceeds one thousand (1,000):

- violation of any of the general privacy principles in the processing of personal data, pursuant to Section 11 of the DPA
- violation of any of the data subject rights pursuant to Section 16 of the DPA
- any repetition of the same infraction, penalized under this Circular





Administrative Fines

Admin Fine: 0.25% to 2% of the annual gross income of the immediately preceding year of the violation

Circular on

Major Violations:

- violation of any of the general privacy principles in (not exceed 1,000 data subjects)
- violation of any of the data subject rights (not exceed 1,000 data subjects)
- Any failure by a personal information controller to implement reasonable and appropriate measures to protect the security of personal information
- Any failure by a personal information controller to ensure that third parties processing personal information on their behalf shall implement security measures
- Any failure by a personal information controller to notify the Commission and affected data subjects of personal data breaches pursuant to Section 20 (f) of the DPA, unless otherwise punishable by Section 30 of the DPA.





Circular on Administrative Fines

Other violations

Fine: not less than Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 50,000) but not exceeding Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000): The failure to register true and updated information with the Commission the identity and contact details of the PIC, the data processing system, and information on automated decision making

Fine not exceeding Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 50,000):

Failure to comply with any Order of the Commission, or of any of its duly-authorized officers; the fine to be imposed as a result of this infraction shall be in addition to the fine-imposed for the original infraction/s subject of the Order of the Commission
